- Admission Quotas(2025 Spring Semester):
 - (A) 4-year Bachelor's degree programs: 149 students
 - (B) 2-year Bachelor's degree programs:36 students
 - (C) Master's degree programs: 8 students
 - (D) Ph.D. program: 3 students
- 2. Duration of study: 4 to 6 years for a 4-year Bachelor's degree program; 2 to 4 years for a 2-year Bachelor's degree program; 1 to 4 years for a Master's degree program. 2 to 7 years for a Ph.D. program.
- 3. An academic year consists of two semesters: The first semester (Fall) begins around the middle of September ending in the middle of January, and the second semester (Spring) begins around the middle of February ending at the end of June.
- 4. International applicants admitted to the spring semester will attend classes with their peers of the same grade level. No extra course is offered.
- 5. All the courses are taught in Mandarin. Applicants should have adequate listening, reading, speaking and writing proficiency in Mandarin at a level sufficient for academic studies.
- 6. Hungkuang University will examine applications supported by a junior college diploma or academic credentials equivalent to a college diploma, and such applicants may apply for credit transfer after being admitted as freshmen or transfer students. Affairs related to credit transfer, transferring to a higher grade level, and academic studies should be subject to the Regulations for Credit Transfer by Students at Hungkuang University and the Academic Rules of Hungkuang University.

A. Eligibilty

Our admission criteria are based on Ministry of Education (MOE) "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan". If the MOE regulations are updated or changed, current regulations will apply. Please contact the MOE for the latest information.

- 1. Any applicant who, at the time of application, is a foreign national, has never held a Taiwan passport, and does not possess Overseas Chinese Student status.
- 2. An applicant of foreign nationality who, pursuant to the following requirements, has continuously resided overseas for no less than 6 years (up to August 01, 2025 is also qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
 - a. An applicant holding both foreign and Taiwan. nationalities, but has never been registered as part of a household in Taiwan.
 - b. An applicant holding foreign nationality, and who once held Taiwan nationality, but has not been registered as part of household in Taiwan for at least 8 years (up to August 01, 2025), as determined by the Ministry of Interior.
 - c. If the preceding two clauses are relevant to an applicant, that applicant must not have studied in Taiwan as an Overseas Chinese Student and have not been approved for student status by the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students in the enrollment year.

According to the Agreement on Educational Cooperation, a foreign national selected by a foreign government, organization, or school, is not subject to the limitations as prescribed in the preceding two paragraphs (however, the individual will still need to obtain approval from relevant Taiwan government agencies). Please note: this is applicable only to applicants who have never been registered as part of a household in Taiwan.

- 3. An applicant holding foreign nationality, concurrently holding a permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macao, has never been registered as part of a household in Taiwan and, at the time of application, has continuously resided in Hong Kong, Macao, or another foreign country (overseas) for no less than 6 years is qualified to apply for admission under these regulations.
- 4. An applicant who is a former citizen of Mainland China, currently holds a foreign nationality, has never been registered as part of a household in Taiwan and, at the time of application, has continuously resided overseas for no less than 6 years is qualified to apply for admission under these regulations.
- 5. The term "overseas" as prescribed in paragraph 2~4 is limited to countries or regions other than Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau. The phrase "continuously reside overseas" means that an individual may stay in Taiwan for a total of not more than 120 days per calendar year. If the calculated calendar year is not a complete one, the stay in Taiwan should not exceed 120 days within the calculated calendar year period.

The only exceptions to this method of calculation are as follows (Please note: these exceptions must be supported by written documentation):

a. Attended Overseas Youth Vocational Training Program organized by the Overseas Compatriot

Affairs Council or technical training classes. Please note: the courses must be MOE accredited.

- b. Attended a Mandarin Chinese language center at a university or college in Taiwan for no more than 2 years. Please note: the educational institution must be MOE accredited.
- c. Exchange students who have studied in Taiwan for no more than 2 years.
- d. An internship lasting for no more than 2 years. Please note: the internship must be authorized by a central government agency.
- 6. In paragraph 2~4, Upon completion of the courses of study, if an international student intends to apply for another program at the same academic level at a school in Taiwan, the student's admission shall be handled in a manner identical to the procedure of admission for local students. In the case of applications for master's degrees or higher levels of graduate studies can the student's admission be processed under the rules of Hungkuang University.
- 7. International students who have graduated from a high school, college or university recognized by the MOE of the Republic of China can apply for admission. International students with a foreign high school diploma are eligible to apply for undergraduate programs; Applicants with a Bachelor's or a Master's degree are eligible to apply for Master programs. Applicants with a Master's degree or equivalent qualifications to that of our academic degree system are eligible to apply for Ph.D. programs.
- 8. International students who are dismissed from schools after admission due to behavioral issues, poor academic performance or a conviction under the Criminal Law may thereafter not apply for admission under the Regulation.
- 9. Application requirements and regulations can be found on the MOE Website. The most up-to-date version of the MOE "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan" is posted on the MOE website at (https://www.edu.tw/Default.aspx). Before submitting an application, please check the MOE and Hungkuang University websites for important information and updates.
- **10.** Application eligibility is based on the MOE "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan". If the MOE regulations are revised, the latest MOE regulations shall prevail, go online to: (https://depart.moe.edu.tw/ED2500/Default.aspx)

 - * "Taiwan's overseas mission" refers to Taiwan embassy, consulate, office or other agencies authorized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA), Taiwan.
 - Academic credentials from Mainland China shall be subject to the Regulations Governing the
 Accreditation of Schools in Mainland China; academic credentials from Hong Kong or
 Macao shall be subject to the Academic Credential Verification and Accreditation Methods
 adopted in Hong Kong and Macao.
 - Academic credentials from Malaysia are required to be authenticated with official stamps by
 a Taiwanese overseas embassy or the Federation of Alumni of Taiwan Universities in
 Malaysia.
 - * Recent graduates are not requested to submit the diploma in the application periods. However, the diploma must be submitted when registering at the school.
- 10. A bank statement showing that the account balance for the past three months is at least US\$ 3,500 (or NT\$ 100,000) or a copy of a scholarship award notification.
- 11. A copy of passport or other equivalent verification as proof of nationality
- 12. Applicants should provide a certificate of language proficiency in Mandarin when applying for admission. For admission to a Mandarin-taught program, a TOCFL (Test of Chinese as a Foreign Language) certificate for Level A2 or above or HSK (Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi) Level 4 or above is required (Native Mandarin speakers are exempt from this requirement).
- 13. Autobiography / Study plan
- *If additional materials are required by specific departments, the applicant shall be notified as needed.

2. Taiwan Scholarship

In an effort to encourage outstanding international students to undertake studies in Taiwan, international students can apply for the government-offered Taiwan Scholarship. Applicants must submit applications for the Taiwan Scholarship to the Taiwan Overseas Mission (TOM) located in their home country or in a nearby country between February 1 and March 31. For more information about the MOFA/MOE Taiwan Scholarship. For a list of Taiwan's overseas missions.

I. Others

- 1. Applicants may apply for a maximum of three degree programs only (filled in the order of choice) and shall abide by all the application requirements as specified
- 2. The diploma submitted for review shall be authenticated in accordance with the rules promulgated by the Taiwan MOE, except for diplomas issued by overseas Taiwanese schools or overseas Chinese schools.
- 3. In accordance with the MOE regulations, students who had been dismissed from a university or college in the Taiwan are not eligible to apply. Applicants who violate this regulation will have their admissions revoked.
- 4. If any violations to the admission qualifications or false information in the submitted documents are found, applicants will be denied admission. If already admitted, the student will be asked to leave. If already graduated, the student will be asked to return his/her diploma.

In accordance with the "Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Chinese Students in Taiwan," the term "Overseas Chinese Student" refers to a student of Chinese descent who has come to Taiwan to study, who was born and lived overseas until the present time, or who has been living overseas for six or more consecutive years in the immediate past and obtained permanent or long-term residency status overseas. Please note that a minimum of eight consecutive years of overseas residency is required if the person is applying to study in a university department of medicine, dentistry, or Chinese medicine in Taiwan.

The term "overseas" refers to countries or regions other than Taiwan, the Mainland Area, Macao, and Hong Kong; the consecutive years of overseas residency means calendar years in each of which an Overseas Chinese Student has not spent more than 120 days in Taiwan. When calculating the number of consecutive years spent overseas, if the initial or final year of the period is not a complete calendar year, any time spent in Taiwan in the initial or final year must not exceed 120 days.
