

Implementation Guidelines for the Overseas Youth Technical Training Program Scholarship at Hungkuang University of Technology

Approved during the University Affairs Meeting on June 21, 2022

1. To reward outstanding students in the Overseas Youth Technical Training Program (hereinafter referred to as “the Program”) at Hungkuang University of Technology (hereinafter referred to as “the University”), these Implementation Guidelines for the Overseas Youth Technical Training Program Scholarship (hereinafter referred to as “the Guidelines”) have been established.
2. The recipients of this scholarship must be current students enrolled in the Program and taking courses on campus during the semester. Students studying abroad for the entire semester are not eligible.
3. The scholarship is awarded based on academic performance each semester (except for the final semester) as follows:
 - First Place: NT\$3,500
 - Second Place: NT\$2,500
 - Third Place: NT\$1,500
4. The scholarship will be awarded after evaluation in the following semester, according to the announcement by the Office of International Affairs (around the 12th week).
5. Scholarship award criteria: students must meet the following basic conditions.
 - The top three students in academic performance in each class are awarded in descending order.

- If a class has 20 or fewer students, only the top two students are awarded.

Basic conditions:

- Conduct grade of 80 or above.
- Academic performance must be within the top 20% of the class (rounded up), with passing grades in all subjects.

In case of a tie in academic average, ranking will be determined by:

- Higher average score in professional courses.
- Higher conduct grade.

If the above criteria still result in a tie, the students share the same ranking, and the scholarship amount is evenly divided.

6. Students who withdraw from the Program will not be awarded the scholarship.

7. The Office of International Affairs, Program Division, will compile a list of recipients based on their academic performance and submit it for approval to the Vice President for International Affairs before public announcement and distribution.

8. These Guidelines shall be implemented upon approval by the International Affairs Meeting and ratification by the University President. Amendments shall follow the same procedure.
